Auro University becomes 1st Private University in South Gujarat to get UGC Recognition

Auro University students can get recognition of their degrees internationally and nationally

UGC recognition allows the university to offer courses to International students

Faculty members of Auro University can avail central government grants and apply for research projects

Surat. Thursday, December 13, 2018: India's first integral education institution, Auro University, Surat, has become the first private university in South Gujarat region to get the University Grant Commission's (UGC) recognition under section 12 (B) of the UGC Act.

This will help Auro University students in terms of recognition of their courses and degrees internationally and nationally.

This recognition will also open new opportunities for international students to study at Auro University. Credits earned at Auro can be considered in their consolidated credits required for the degree through credit transfers. International students can pursue full time courses at Auro University.

With this recognition Auro University is eligible for central assistance (UGC Grant) from the Government of India or any organisation receiving funds from the Central Government.

Now all the faculty members of the university can avail grants and apply for research projects from organisations like ICSSR (Indian Council for Social Science Research) and other agencies. These organisations give research projects and grants only to those private universities that are recognised under Section 12 (B) of the UGC Act.

Vice Chancellor of the University Prof. Avadhesh Kumar Singh said, “We welcome the UGC’s recognition with great pride. It is a recognition of the promoters’ vision, efforts of the University’s family of faculties and staff, as well as our unflinching commitment to the values that the university stands for.”

He further added, “We feel it will change social perception. This can also bring diversity as students from various parts of India and abroad can pursue courses offered by Auro University.”

The UGC recognition is difficult to get for private universities. A team of experts from UGC had visited the university in April this year to inspect the functioning of the university as per the rules and regulations set for the recognition under Section 12 (B) of the UGC Act.

The vision of Auro University is to be a premier University of Integral and Transformational Learning for future leaders. It believes that education must not be limited to academic learning. At AURO, the focus will be to develop all faculties of an individual to ensure holistic development.
